- iii. Issues in verification of uploaded photos of the institute: The inspection team could not verify the pictures of the institute because the pictures submitted at the time of application were inaccessible. Due to this issue, visual confirmation of the institute's infrastructure and facilities could not be carried out.
- iv. Laboratory Facilities: The botany, chemistry, geography, and zoology laboratories were not equipped properly and were poorly maintained; no water facility or drainage system was there; The language laboratory did not have a single computer, and no language learning software was installed in their lab.
- v. Washrooms for physically challenged individuals were not appropriate because they were not spacious and not equipped with the necessary arrangements as prescribed by NCTE norms.
- vi. The library lacks essential encyclopedias and reference materials related to education. This deficiency limits academic support for both students and faculty.

Therefore, the Committee decided that Show Cause Notice Post Inspection be issued to the institution thereby providing an opportunity for making representation through online transition application portal of NCTE, within 07 days along with all relevant supporting documents from the date of issue of Show Cause Notice.

Decision of WRC:

The online application of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in terms of Section 14 (1)/15 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 the institution for transition from B.A. B.Ed. / B.Sc. B.Ed. Programme to 4-Year Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) for the session 2026-27 along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Virtual Inspection Report dated 02.04.2026, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents uploaded by the institution were carefully considered by the WRC, NCTE and the Committee observed as under:

- i. Electronic Publication not available.
- ii. Digital or Online Resources not available.
- iii. Lack of science stream laboratory, instructional and other infrastructure.
- iv. A very few students are admitted in existing B.Sc. B.Ed.
- v. The institution building is G+1; however, it does not have a ramp facility, nor is there any provision for a lift, which is a violation of the norms of the National Council for Teacher Education.
- vi. Few labs are not up to mark, needs to be upgraded.

Therefore, the Committee decided that Show Cause Notice Post Inspection be issued to the institution thereby providing an opportunity for making representation through online transition application portal of NCTE, within 07 days along with all relevant supporting documents from the date of issue of Show Cause Notice.
